AWARD OF MERIT

After awarding Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best of Opposite Sex, the judge may present Awards of Merit to the exhibits competing in the Best of Breed ring that are, in the judge's opinion, outstanding specimens of the breed. The total number of Awards of Merit is determined by the number of dogs and bitches competing in Best of Breed as follows: 1-10 entries = 1; 11-14 entries = 2; 15-20 = 3. In the event that Best of Breed entries exceed 20, the Club reserves the right to offer additional Awards of Merit. Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch are not eligible for any Awards of Merit.

GRAND CHAMPION POINTS

Champions of Record and dogs which have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed that are entered in Best of Breed competition are eligible for Grand Championship competition. Grand Championship points may be recorded for: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, and Select Bitch. Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and Non-Regular Class winners, that are not conformation Champions, are not eligible for Grand Championship points. ABOUT OUR JUDGES

Mrs. Sally L. Vilas – Conformation

My late husband, Bob, and I began showing Poodles, first in Obedience and then in Conformation, many years ago. We 'discovered' Shih Tzu about the time they were recognized by AKC. Both breeds are wonderful family companions, which was important for our situation where show dogs were kept in small numbers in a home situation. They had to enjoy life with our two sons and their friends. We produced Champions in both breeds. At one time, we were specializing BIS BISS Ch. Vilenzo Red Rover Red Rover (Shih Tzu) and BISS Ch. Vilenzo Othello (Standard Poodle) mostly in California. Both were recognized as producers.

I began judging Poodles and Shih Tzu in 1993 and now judge the Toy Group, Non Sporting Group, Junior Showmanship and Best in Show. I've had the pleasure of judging the Shih Tzu national specialty twice - and to be invited to judge Toys & Non-Sporting in Japan & Australia.

The invitation to judge this specialty took me back in memory to 2003, when I flew to Glenmont NY to judge Sweepstakes at a CSPCA Eastern Regional Specialties ... what an exciting step that was along the path to judging this breed.

I've been an involved member of several clubs at the local and national level: American Shih Tzu Club (President 1996-2006) currently Recording Secretary and AKC Delegate; Golden Gate Shih Tzu Fanciers: Treasurer; Nor-Cal Toy Dog Fanciers: Founding member, Director, Show Chairman; Poodle Club of America: approved mentor/ judges education; Poodle Club of Central California: current Show Chair & V.P.

Mrs. Judy Meitin -- Sweepstakes

I volunteered for this judging assignment because I love California and the people from there and Arizona. I have had Shar-Pei since 1981, shown since 1983, and spent time at dog shows and horse shows until my last horse passed in the late nineties.

I had the privilege of owning CH Meiting Luv Wun MacMurfee ROM, his sire CH Maxi Headroom ROM, CH Meiting Roll of the Dice ROM, and bred several other champions, which for the most part, were shown by myself. My favorite part of showing is meeting up with friends and going to Nationals annually.

I am "down" to 6 dogs, five of which are champions. My daughter and twin brother live with me now and I haven't retired yet, but hope to do so soon!!!

Mrs. Anne K. Catterson – Conformation

Anne Catterson has been breeding and exhibiting since the '80's, starting with Boston Terriers and adding Brussels Griffons to the household shortly thereafter. She has bred dozens of champions as well as a National Specialty winner, all under the Bobcat kennel name. Bobcat dogs were always owner-handled, either by Anne or son Paul, as a Junior. Anne still maintains and handles both breeds but son Paul has long since graduated from Junior Handler to Professional Handler.

Anne participates in several dog organizations in various capacities: President and Show Coordinator for the Pasadena Boston Terrier club; Vice-President of the Sand-to-Sea Non-Sporting Association, and Governor on the Board of Directors of the American Brussels Griffon Association. Her all-breed affiliation is with the Kennel Club of Riverside, where she is Treasurer and Show Chair.

Having gone to school "back in the day" when English Composition was of prime importance, Anne discovered an ability to put pen to paper regarding various aspects of dogs and dog shows. She practices this skill mostly for the Brussels Griffon parent club, editing and publishing the ABGA Bulletin, and writing the Brussels Griffon breed column for the AKC Gazette. She has also had articles published in *Top Notch Toy* and *Dog News*.

She has been an AKC judge since 1999. She is currently approved to judge several Non-Sporting and Toy breeds, and Jr. Showmanship. In addition to judging for AKC, she often judges for ARBA (American Rare Breed Association) and ASCA (Australian Shepherd Club of America).

Mr. Bill Edwards -- Sweepstakes

Bill Edwards has been active in pure bred dogs since 1974 when he acquired his first Bull Terrier as a pet. Although no longer an exhibitor, he was a breeder of specialty winning and group placing Bull Terriers for 22 years, four of which, through their exhibition years, finished #1 in AKC breed standings.

In 1998, Bill was approved by the AKC to judge Bull Terriers and miniature Bull Terriers. Since that time he has added the balance of the Terrier Group plus the Herding Group and is continuing on with breeds in the Non-Sporting Group. He has judged AKC specialties and all-breed shows throughout the United States, Russia, and China; he also judges for the American Rare Breed Association, FCI organizations and the International All Breed Canine Association.

Bill lives with his wife Patricia in Glendale, California. Since his retirement from the railroad in 2006, Bill spends this time traveling the world with his wife and judging dog shows, both of which he thoroughly enjoys.

Chinese Shar-Pei Breed Standard

General Appearance: An alert, compact dog of medium size and substance; square in profile, close coupled; the well-proportioned head slightly, but not overly large for the body. The short, harsh coat, the loose skin covering the head and body, the small ears, the "hippopotamus" muzzle shape and the high set tail impart to the Shar-Pei a unique look peculiar to him alone. The loose skin and wrinkles covering the head, neck and body are superabundant in puppies but these features may be limited to the head, neck and withers in the adult.

Size, Proportion, Substance: The height is 18 to 20 inches at the withers. The weight is 45 to 60 pounds. The dog is usually larger and more square-bodied than the bitch but both appear well proportioned. The height of the Shar-Pei from the ground to the withers is approximately equal to the length from the point of breastbone to the point of rump.

Head and Skull: The head is large, slightly, but not overly, proudly carried and covered with profuse wrinkles on the forehead continuing into side wrinkles framing the face. *Eyes*--Dark, small, almond-shaped and sunken, displaying a scowling expression. In the dilute colored dogs the eye color may be lighter. *Ears*--extremely small, rather thick, equilateral triangles in shape, slightly rounded at the tips; edges of the ear may curl. Ears lie flat against the head, are set high, wide apart and forward on the skull, pointing toward the eyes. The ears have the ability to move. *A pricked ear is a disqualification.* *Skull*--flat and broad, the stop moderately defined. *Muzzle*--one of the distinctive features of the breed. It is broad and full with no suggestion of snippiness. (The length from nose to stop is approximately the same as from stop to occiput.) *Nose* large and wide and darkly pigmented, preferably black but any color conforming to the general coat color of the dog is acceptable. In dilute colors, the preferred nose is self-colored. Darkly pigmented cream Shar-Pei may have some light pigment either in the center of the nose or on the entire nose. The lips and top of muzzle are well-padded and may cause a slight bulge above the nose. *Tongue, roof of mouth, gums and flews*--solid bluish-black is preferred in all coat colors except in dilute colors, which have a solid lavender pigmentation. A spotted pink tongue is a major fault. *A solid pink tongue is a disqualification.* (Tongue colors may lighten due to heat stress; care must be taken not to confuse dilute pigmentation with a pink tongue.) *Teeth*--strong, meeting in a scissors bite. Deviation from a scissors bite is a major fault.

Neck, Topline, Body: *Neck*--medium length, full and set well into the shoulders. There are moderate to heavy folds of loose skin and abundant dewlap about the neck and throat. The *topline* dips slightly behind the withers, slightly rising over the short, broad loin. A level, roach or swayed topline/backline shall be faulted. *Chest*--broad and deep with the brisket extending to the elbow and rising slightly under the loin. *Back*--short and close-coupled. *Croup*--flat, with the base of the tail set extremely high, clearly exposing an up-tilted anus. *Tail*--the high set tail is a characteristic feature of the Shar-Pei. A low set tail shall be faulted. The tail is thick and round at the base, tapering to a fine point and curling over or to either side of the back. *The absence of a complete tail is a disqualification.*

Forequarters: *Shoulders*--muscular, well laid back and sloping. *Forelegs*--when viewed from the front, straight moderately spaced, with elbows close to the body. When viewed from the side, the forelegs are straight, the pasterns are strong and flexible. The bone is substantial but never heavy and is of moderate length. Removal of front dewclaws is optional. *Feet*--moderate in size, compact and firmly set, not splayed.

Hindquarters: Muscular, strong, and moderately angulated. The **metatarsi** (hocks) are short, perpendicular to the ground and parallel to each other when viewed from the rear. Hind dewclaws must be removed. Feet as in front.

Coat: The extremely harsh coat is one of the distinguishing features of the breed. The coat is absolutely straight and off standing on the main trunk of the body but generally lies somewhat flatter on the limbs. The coat appears healthy without being shiny or lustrous. Acceptable coat lengths may range from extremely short "horse coat" up to the "brush coat," not to exceed one inch in length at the withers. A soft coat, a wavy coat, a coat in excess of one inch at the withers or a coat that has been trimmed is a major fault. The Shar-Pei is shown in its natural state.

Color: Only solid colors and sable are acceptable and are to be judged on an equal basis. A solid color dog may have shading, primarily darker, down the back and on the ears. The shading must be variations of the same body color and may include darker hairs throughout the coat. *The following colors are disqualifications: Albino; Not a solid color, i.e.: Brindle; Parti-colored; Spotted; Patterned in any combination of colors.*

Gait: The movement of the Shar-Pei is to be judged at a trot. The gait is free and balanced with the feet tending to converge on a center line of gravity when the dog moves at a vigorous trot. The gait combines good forward reach and strong drive in the hindquarters. Proper movement is essential.

Temperament: Regal, alert, intelligent, dignified, lordly, scowling, sober and snobbish essentially independent and somewhat standoffish with strangers, but extreme in his devotion to his family. The Shar-Pei stands firmly on the ground with a calm, confident stature.

Major Faults:

Deviation from a Scissors Bite.

Spotted Tongue.

A soft coat, a wavy coat, a coat in excess of 1" in length at the withers or a coat that has been trimmed.

Disqualifications

Pricked ears

Solid pink tongue

Absence of a complete tail

Albino; not a solid color, i.e.: Brindle; Parti-colored; Spotted; Patterned in any combination of colors
